At the AGM we reflect on the previous school year but before we delve into that it would be remiss of me not to mention the Corona Virus and the challenges that it presented to our staff, children and families, in this school year. Like everyone else impacted by this we have faced significant upheaval to our organisation and were challenged by trying to do the best by our families and our staff which at times meant making some conflicting decisions - what was best for our families who continued to need and use the centre was not necessarily what was best for staff. Thankfully, I can report that we have navigated the challenges calmly and practically and to date have not had any known cases of COVID-19 at the Centre. We have implemented Job Keeper payments for qualified staff and casuals and reduced our outgoings significantly, to allow the Centre to weather the storm as best as possible. Our objective always being to provide the community with the service that we know they depend upon as well as maintaining the health and safety of all our employees.

I would like to use this opportunity to thank all the staff that have worked so hard through this challenging time. From all the committee - **thank you!**

As if that was not enough of a drama to deal with, we decided to press ahead with our scheduled business transformation project - which was a key pillar of our strategy laid out at last year's AGM. Our strategy was to update our bookings and enrolment process, launch our own new website and



replace the current administrator with a new more cost effective and customer centric organisation. I am incredibly pleased and honoured to announce that we have been able to deliver this with minimum disruption to staff and parents! As regular users of the Centre will know we are no longer using Becklyn as our administrator, website provider and booking system. We have now moved over to a new platform called XPLOR and partnered with CCSA to manage our business administration.
